What is QuesTECH Learning?

QuesTECH Learning (QTL), an educational services center serving NELA students and their families for over twenty-six years thanks to the efforts of our Founder Alex George, recognizes that 21st Century learning is not simply about the school but about learning in various formats.

QTL offers numerous ways to learn: full-time online school with certified teachers for grades 6-12, blended environment of online courses with mentors on site at QTL, individual online courses for grades 6-12, continued full-time day school for grades 2-8, after school tutorials, summer programs for remediation or enrichment, and ACT preparation (online, workshops, tutorials, and Speed Reader) as well as prep all any standardized test.

QuesTECH Higher Learning offers an online/blended high school program.

Accredited by the Louisiana Department of Education and COGNIA, QuesTECH Higher

Learning has become an online partner with Schools PLP, which offers traditional high school, as well as career readiness, pathways to high school graduation.

Online students, grades 6-12, who need additional instructional resources beyond the numerous ways afforded through Schools PLP, may schedule mentoring sessions in a blended environment: virtual instruction coupled with on-site assistance to produce whatever best suits student need.

QuesTECH Learning will continue to offer the full day school for grades 2-8, serving students who, for whatever reason, need a more specialized environment and curriculum. The full day school offers a nontraditional, smaller environment for students



with or without formal diagnoses of ADHD, dyslexia, and/or autism, among others. The day school has also enabled students without diagnoses the opportunity for academic remediation or challenge. An invaluable part of the full day school is Believe and Achieve Therapy, which offers qualifying students occupational as well as speech and language therapies through Christi Howard, M.A., CCC-SLP, and Ann Tubre, LOTR, and their devoted clinicians.



QuesTECH Learning will continue to offer after school tutorials, face-to-face or virtually, in any academic subject, kindergarten through college. Test preparation is a given: ACT, SAT, ASVAB, GMAT, GEE, LEAP, EOC, and MCAT, to name a few. QTL provides ACT preparation in several formats: workshops and one-on-one or small group instruction. Mary Katherine Murphy and Donna Underwood have taken their ACT Workshops in math/science and English/reading into seven NE LA parishes to help high school students reach their ACT goals.

Since its inception in 1997, QTL instructors have helped thousands of students not enrolled in the full school program through after school tutorials and summer programs.

In May 2022, QTL expanded its mission, "Achieving Maximum Potential . . . Become Productive Citizens," by opening QuesTECH Spectrum, which will enable QTL to help young adults, many on the autism spectrum, to have valued employment in a silk screening business, coordinated by Manager Crystal Rhymes. QTL Spectrum will create tee shirts, banners, and signs as employed young people acquire important skills that will help them as they become valuable members of a 21st-century workforce.

Stars on the Bayou, QTL's annual fundraiser, is scheduled for November 11 at ULM's The Hangar. Amanda Lyon of Empire Management and Media is coordinating the regional talent show with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each of four categories. Encouraging young talent is just another way that QTL values its community.
